- Once you have submitted your application, we will get in touch with you to discuss it further. We will either arrange a time for you to visit Westport, or will catch up with you via a video call.
- We have up to 4 places available in our Mission House at any one time. Availability depends on other applicants.
- If you are accepted to come and be part of MTB, you will need to sign the House Covenant which outlines our expectations and commitments. You will be expected to pay a contribution of \$30 per week towards accommodation costs (includes electricity but not internet or food).
- Successful applicants will need to agree to undergoing a police check because of the nature of ministry that you may be involved with.
